Board-certified cosmetic plastic surgeon Dr. Josef Hadeed, who thinks Daisy may have had a chin implant and rhinoplasty, agrees. "Whatever she's done, it is certainly subtle," he says. It all comes down to Daisy's philosophy about knowing when to say "when." "So many women in Hollywood change their faces radically, all at one time," says Philadelphia plastic surgeon Dr. Kirk Brandow. "Daisy looks great."



FOREHEAD "Her forehead is ooth," observes skin specialist Martino, "free of ep wrinkles and fine lines.' How do you look that way at 50? Martino thinks Botox, at \$400 to \$450 a treatment.

CHEEKS

NYC dermatologist Dr. Gary Goldenberg notes Daisy's face is more full now. "Some of this may be weight gain," he says, "but I believe she's had fillers, too." Cost: \$1.2K to \$5K.

SKIN

"Her face has very little visible sun damage Martino notes, adding that a more even complexion car be achieved with laser skin resurfacing. Price tag: \$2K to \$3K.

LIPS Dr. Hadeed believes Daisy's had lip fillers, observing that "she previously did not have a well-defined Cupid's bow in her upper lip, but she does have one currently. Injections cost \$600 to \$1.2K.

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
